

AFFIDAVIT OF TERRY SPIELER

I, Terry Spieler, being first duly sworn under oath do hereby swear and affirm as follows:

1. I am over the age of twenty-one (21) and not otherwise disqualified from giving this Affidavit. I reside at 34957 Highway 11, California, Missouri 65018.

2. I currently am and have been since at least 1982, the Secretary of the Missouri Senate. In that capacity I am official custodian of all legislation that originates in or is passed by the Missouri Senate. I supervise the enrolling and engrossing of all bills and resolutions that are truly agreed to and finally passed. The enrolling and engrossing process is used to determine the true and accurate language of all measures passed by the Missouri Senate and to correct errors. It is not unusual for the Enrolling and Engrossing Department of the Senate Secretary's office to find errors in the Truly Agreed To And Finally Passed version of a bill or resolution as printed for the Senate Bill Room, from which the public can retrieve hard copies of legislation. Whenever errors are found in the enrolling and engrossing process, a new Truly Agreed To And Finally Passed version of the bill or resolution is prepared with the word "corrected" in brackets [Corrected] added.

3. On May 14, 2004, the Missouri General Assembly Truly Agreed To and Finally Passed Senate Joint Resolution 29 (SJR 29). Under Senate Rule 70, all Resolutions to amend the Constitution are treated as Bills. The original and official copy of SJR 29 is in my possession in the Enrolling and Engrossing Department in a black, 8 1/2 X 11 folder. I have never delivered SJR 29 to the Missouri Secretary of State, the Governor, the Missouri Attorney General or anyone outside of the Missouri General Assembly.
