Treatment Court Program Status


As of Mar. 31, 2013, there were 132 treatment court programs: 90 adult, 7 juvenile, 12 family, 18 designated DWI, 1 reintegration, and 4 veterans courts serving 12 counties. The commission provided funding to 49 treatment court jurisdictions that include 126 treatment court programs.

Participants

As of Mar. 31, 2013, there were 3,454 individuals participating in treatment courts as measured by a count of cases. The adult category includes reintegration, veterans, and adult drug courts unless otherwise noted.


Total Participant Trend




Admissions

There were 175 admissions to treatment courts during this reporting period as measured by a count of cases. The number of admissions for calendar 2013 is 592. Re-entry also includes reintegration case types.

The following is known about all adult treatment court admissions for this reporting period:

- The average age at admission was slightly over 33 years old.
- Admissions range in age from 18 to 65 years old.

Termination includes termination and voluntary withdrawal.

As of Mar. 31, 2013, there have been a total of 12,667 treatment court graduates.

A total of 651 babies have been born to female participants during treatment. **596 of these have been born drug free.**

- Five drug free babies were born to participants that exited treatment court during this reporting period.
- Two drug exposed babies were born to participants that exited treatment court during this reporting period.

Note: Current period plus prior period calendar year totals may not equal the current calendar year totals due to cases that were added after reports for the prior period were run.
