

-In addition to litigation, I have tried to expand my practice and knowledge over the years. My experiences have been very diverse. Some examples are as follows:

-I presided over official evidentiary disciplinary hearings as president of the Kansas City Board of Police Commissioners. We heard appeals of police officers who had been suspended for more than 15 days or who were recommended for termination. These hearings were judicial in nature. Attorneys questioned witnesses, presented evidence and made objections. I ruled on objections during these hearings. Following the presentation of evidence and closing statements, the board voted on whether to follow the recommendation of the Chief of Police or to make its own determination.

-I received training as a certified mediator (1999) and arbitrator (2001) and have steadily increased the number of mediations I conduct each year. I serve as a neutral and assist folks in resolving pending disputes. I am confronted with all types of people, issues, cultural differences, and personalities. I have conducted over 1,600 mediations. I am on the approved list of mediators for Clay and Platte Counties and also serve as a mediator for M.A.R.C.H (Mediation Achieving Results for Children) and the Office of Dispute Resolution in Clay County. I am pleased to say that many attorneys send their clients to me for mediation. It has certainly been good experience to serve as a neutral and to practice active listening skills as I keep parties on track in the mediation process. I mediate in divorce, custody, child support, paternity, construction law, personal injury, contracts and probate matters.

-I served as a special deputy receiver of a life and health insurance company. This assignment involved taking control of a life and health insurance company that was in financial jeopardy. I had to assure that all remaining claims were resolved and that pending litigation was concluded. Complex issues arose including sale of the corporate shell and licenses, records retention, corporate tax matters, insurance licensing matters and health insurance claims fraud. I developed expertise in processing the rehabilitation and liquidation of an insurance company. We were able to complete the liquidation of the company with no complaints and remaining assets were turned over to the rightful shareholder. I am confident in my ability to grasp complex matters quickly.

-I developed an estate planning practice over the years with the help of those with whom I worked as well as through self study, specialized seminars and taking a course in gift and estate tax at UMKC Law School. I have enjoyed working with my clients in this area and have made house calls and hospital visits with my secretary when needed for disabled clients. I am comfortable dealing with people from all walks of life.

In over 26 years of practice, I have been a general practitioner, representing clients in an extraordinarily wide range of matters. The Court of Appeals ruled in my favor, allowing me to put on a key defense witness. The jury found my client not guilty.

I was appointed to the Board of Police Commissioners of Kansas City, Missouri on Dec. 22, 1998 and served as a member until March 20, 2003. This Board consists of four appointed members and the Mayor of Kansas City, Missouri. I served my last two years as President of the Board. With input from the police command staff and legal counsel, the Board set police policy, worked with the city council regarding the police department budget, supervised litigation matters, engaged in extensive long range planning, and developed positive community relations. We were also responsible for hiring the Police Chief-our first task after I was appointed. I maintained my full-time practice of law while serving on the board. I had the good fortune of working with a multitude of great people within the police department and in the greater Kansas City community, and found the experience invaluable.

I am most proud of the action we took to address long-term capital needs of the department. We analyzed the workings of the department, and noted its deficiencies. For example, our police academy was located in an old warehouse and was not conducive to recruiting or training new officers. We formed a committee in cooperation with the Kansas City Fire Department (KeepSafe) to study our public safety needs. We worked with state legislators, the city council and community leaders as we planned and presented the future public safety needs of the city and how to fund improvements. The result was the construction of a new, state of the art police academy and police station, which will serve our city for many years, while attracting outside funds from other cities and agencies who wish to utilize our academy for law enforcement training. Additionally, the fire department was able to construct new facilities and make improvements to their deteriorating structures. I am proud of our efforts in building community relationships and working together to improve public safety.
