

12. Describe the nature and extent of your experience as a practicing attorney in the trial and appellate courts, and explain how such experience demonstrates the quality of your legal work.

Prior to being appointed as a Judge, I was in private practice for over 26 years. I was a general practitioner, representing many clients (plaintiff and defendant) in an extraordinarily wide range of matters. I tried numerous cases over the years in Clay, Platte, Jackson, Grundy and Harrison counties. My experience included:

I successfully represented clients in many bench trials regarding divorce, custody, juvenile, criminal, traffic, DWI, contract and landlord-tenant disputes. I served as appointed guardian ad litem in paternity and dissolution cases concerning custody and the best interests of the minor child or children. I have had jury trials in criminal, personal injury and contract cases with success. I also had the opportunity to work for the criminal division of the Missouri Attorney General during and after law school doing research, preparing appellate briefs and presenting oral arguments. The variety of matters that I handled in my practice prepared me well for my current position as a judge, allowing me to identify issues and be familiar with the law in many areas. Additionally, I received training as an arbitrator and mediator. I conducted hundreds of mediations from 1999-2010 involving paternity, dissolution, personal injury and breach of contract. This helped me to develop the patience and listening skills necessary to be a judge.

-State of Missouri v. Homer Farler, Circuit Court of Harrison County (Judge J Morgan Donelson presiding).

I represented the defendant in a jury trial. He had been charged with felony possession of marijuana with intent to distribute. The jury found the defendant not guilty.

-City of Parkville v. Tuf Flight, Inc. (Circuit Court of Platte County Div. 2, Judge Owens Lee Hull, Jr. presiding):

I represented the landowner (defendant) in this non-jury case which involved an attempt by the municipality to condemn my client's commercial property for private development. I successfully defended the case to the extent that my client was able to sell the property to a private entity and was not forced to give up the property for less than market value. Date of Disposition: September 8, 2003.

-State of Missouri v. Christopher Osbern, (Circuit Court of Platte County, Judge Ward B. Stuckey presiding).

In this jury trial, I represented the defendant who had been charged with forcible rape and faced life in prison. The jury found the defendant not guilty. Date of Disposition: September 14, 1995.

-Ragan v. Luzicka, Circuit Court of Clay County, Division 2, Judge David Russell presiding.

I represented a contractor/builder in a jury trial against a property owner for

breach of a construction contract for non-payment upon completion of the project. The owner filed a counterclaim for damage to property. The jury awarded damages for each party, but the result was a net gain to my client of approximately \$20,000. Date of Disposition: 9/28/1994

Coves North Homes Association v. Nelson Construction Company, Circuit Court of Platte County, Division 2. I represented the Homes Association regarding an injunction to remove prefabricated buildings that had been installed by the defendant without homes association approval. The matter was disposed of by agreement on September 17, 1999.

Shae Ricketts v. Christopher Deshon, Clay County Circuit Court, Div. 4. I represented the plaintiff who had been injured in an automobile collision. I served as co-counsel and 2nd chair at the jury trial. The jury returned a verdict of \$50,000 for my client. Date of Disposition: 6/23/97.

Sloan v. Sloan- Circuit Court of Platte County, Div.3. I represented respondent in a dissolution and child custody matter. The marriage was dissolved, property was divided and child custody was awarded to my client. Date of Disposition: 11/13/2006

Shelter Insurance Co. v. Robert Davis, et al., Clay County Circuit Court, Division 2. I represented Jason Bernard who as a passenger had been injured in a serious automobile collision. My client was entitled to recovery of underinsured motorist coverage. A settlement was reached and the matter was disposed of on January 21, 2005.

Home Insurance Co. v. Butler, et al., Clay County Circuit Court, Division 2. I represented a young lady whose mother had been murdered. The person convicted of murdering my client's mother (my client's step father) had appealed his conviction and was attempting to recover the life insurance proceeds. I eventually obtained summary judgment in favor of my client and the Court of Appeals upheld the Circuit Court's ruling. My client received the insurance proceeds. Date of Disposition: June 13, 1996.

McMickle v. McMickle, Clay County Circuit Court, Division 7. I represented a party regarding the modification of child support. The original order had set forth an amount for two children but one child had become emancipated and the other child had serious health concerns. Judgment was rendered following trial and an appeal ensued.

15. If you are serving or have served in a judicial capacity, describe the nature and extent of your judicial responsibilities, the types of dockets handled, and any special expertise developed.

I currently serve as Associate Circuit Judge in Division 5 of the Platte County Circuit Court. Since I began my service as a judge in May 2010, I have presided over five jury trials as well as numerous bench trials and contested hearings occurring almost every week for the last three years. This extensive experience in trial procedure and evidentiary rulings has prepared me well for the position of Circuit Judge.

In 2012, there were 2,815 civil filings in my division and we disposed of 2,823 civil cases. In 2012, we had 6,259 criminal and traffic cases filed in my division and we disposed of 5,765 such cases. I have regular dockets on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Mondays and Fridays are generally set aside for trials and contested motion hearings. Division 5 is generally busy.

My dockets are as follows: Tuesdays starting at 9 a.m. I have landlord-tenant, unlawful detainer, breach of contract and other civil matters, followed by trials (generally landlord-tenant trials). Tuesdays at 1:30 p.m. I have the misdemeanor criminal docket involving charges of assault, stealing, drug offenses, violations of orders of protection, conservation violations, animal abuse cases, and probation violations. I accept guilty pleas on these days as well.

Wednesdays at 9 a.m. I have the DWI and Driving while suspended cases and probation violations. Several of these cases are resolved by guilty pleas. Trials in these cases are generally scheduled for Mondays or Fridays. On Wednesday at 1:30, I conduct the traffic docket which primarily involves guilty pleas but also occasional trials.

On Thursdays at 9 a.m. I have a civil docket which includes contract matters, personal injury, small claims, some dissolutions, custody, paternity, property damage and petitions for review regarding refusal to take a breathalyzer or review of administrative suspension of driving privilege. I developed a mediation program for the small claims cases in which 5 attorneys serve on a rotating basis as volunteer mediators to help folks resolve their cases. Since implementing this program, approximately 60% of the small claims are resolved through mediation. Those cases not resolved are tried to the court. Thursday afternoons twice per month are set aside for trials and contested hearings which may include various civil or criminal matters and motions to suppress.

Thursday afternoons twice per month, I preside over the DWI Treatment Court which is a specialized court to deal with the multiple DWI offenders. I initiated the development of this program pursuant to then Chief Justice Price's encouragement to all circuits to develop treatment courts to better deal with substance abuse multiple offenders and reduce the cost of incarceration that is incurred by our taxpayers. Treatment courts have shown to be effective in reducing recidivism.

Our DWI Court is a comprehensive and rigorous treatment program for prior driving while intoxicated offenders. The Program requires twice per month court appearances in my division. It also requires participation in extensive treatment which includes random drug/alcohol testing (minimum of twice per week), group and individual substance abuse treatment counseling (three times per week), regular visits to the probation officer and regular attendance at self-help support group meetings. Each participant is also expected to obtain and maintain full-time employment and/or be actively involved in vocational or education programs. If one is not employed, I am likely to require that participant to do community service. All participants are expected to perform community service in the fourth phase of the program in any event. The Program length is a minimum of 52 weeks [an average of 56-72 weeks], but is ultimately determined by each participant's progress. DWI Courts operate under the auspices of the Drug Court Coordinating Commission. The Commission requires that DWI Court personnel be properly trained by an approved training program in order for the DWI Court to receive final approval. Our team included me as Judge, Clerk, Prosecuting Attorneys, Counselors, Director of Tri-County Mental Health Services, Inc. and a Professor from Park University. We all attended specialized training in Springfield, Missouri. Pursuant to Supreme Court Operating Rule 26, the DWI Court was approved by the Drug Court Coordinating Commission. Our program began operation in April of 2011 and 31 people have graduated thus far. My team and I have also received national training to operate a Drug Court program, should one be developed in Platte County. We did not request funding from the county to train, create and operate our existing court program and thus we have had no effect on increasing the county budget.

The case was disposed of by a jury verdict on December 5, 2011. Defendant's Appeal was dismissed by the Court of Appeals.**
 - b. **State of Missouri v. Tyler Chambers. I presided over a jury trial in which the defendant was tried for Driving While Intoxicated. The jury found defendant guilty on January 10, 2012.**
 - c. **Woodson v. Conner, I presided over a jury trial involving an automobile collision. Both parties claimed personal injury. The case was disposed of by jury verdict on July 11, 2011.**

- d. **Maskill v. Cummins.** I presided over this bench trial involving both a partition of real property and a breach of promissory note case. The partition action was previously pending in circuit court and had been transferred to my division. Following trial, I rendered a judgment on October 31, 2011. The judgment was affirmed on appeal.
- e. **State of Missouri v. Stephen Lee Price.** I presided over a jury trial in which the defendant was tried for driving while intoxicated. The defendant was found not guilty by the jury on April 24, 2012.
- f. **Rothlisberger, et al v. Rodgers.** I presided over this bench trial involving a breach of contract for landscaping and construction services. Both parties claimed damages. I rendered judgment on December 7, 2012.
- g. **Eat Advertising and Design, Inc. v. Pirtle Winery, LLC.** I presided over this bench trial in which both parties claimed damages for breach of contract, etc. I rendered judgment and plaintiff's motion for new trial or to amend the judgment was denied on April 30, 2013.
- h. **State of Missouri v. Christopher Allen Walters.** I presided over this jury trial in which defendant was tried for driving while intoxicated. The jury rendered a guilty verdict on March 13, 2012.
- i. **Humes v. Humes.** I presided over this dissolution matter involving distribution of marital property and liabilities and maintenance. Judgment was rendered on September 15, 2010.
- j. **Scheetz v. Budzinski.** I presided over this bench trial involving breach of a promissory note. I rendered judgment for the defendant on November 13, 2012.

20. Do you now or have you ever held any elective or appointive public office or position? If so, please explain. YES

I was appointed by Governor Carnahan to the Board of Police Commissioners of Kansas City, Missouri on Dec. 22, 1998 and was subsequently confirmed by the Missouri Senate. I served as a member of the board until March 20, 2003. The Board consisted of four appointed members and the Mayor of Kansas City, Missouri. I served my last two years as President of the Board. With input from the police command staff and legal counsel, the Board set police policy, worked with the city council regarding the police department budget, made decisions regarding resolution of litigation matters, engaged in extensive long range planning, and developed positive relationships with community leaders throughout Kansas City. We were also responsible for hiring the Police Chief--our first task after I was appointed in 1998. I maintained my full-time practice of law while serving on the board. I had the good fortune of working with a multitude of great people within the police department and in the greater Kansas City community, and found the experience invaluable.

I am most proud of the action we took to address long-term capital needs of the department. We analyzed every aspect of the department, and noted its deficiencies. For example, our police academy was located in an old warehouse and was not conducive to recruiting or training new officers. We formed a committee ("KeepSafe") to study our public safety needs. We worked with state legislators, the city council and community leaders as we planned and presented the future public safety needs of the city and how to fund improvements. The result was the construction of a new, state of the art police academy and police

station, which will serve the city for many years, while attracting outside agencies who wish to utilize the academy for law enforcement training. Additionally, the fire department was able to construct new facilities and make improvements to their deteriorating structures. I am pleased that I had the opportunity to build community relationships and work with so many good folks to help improve public safety.

Edward Rose v. Laurence Jarvis, et al, Jackson County Circuit Court case number 02CV213448. Action brought against Laurence Jarvis, in a matter in which I served solely as local counsel. The case was dismissed with prejudice as to me on October 24, 2003 and no amounts were paid to plaintiff by me or my insurance carrier.
