**Response to 10
Trial Level Experience**

1. *LCRA v. Inserra*, Cause No. 0822-CC00230 (Circuit Court of the City of St. Louis, 2008). I represented the Land Clearance for Redevelopment Authority, and Frank Duda, Anderson & Gilbert, LC, 515 Olive, Suite 704, St. Louis, MO 63101 represented the defendant. This was a jurisdictional hearing in a condemnation action involving property south of Busch Stadium. The issue before the court was whether the property was blighted and whether the LCRA had engaged in good faith negotiations. I was sole trial counsel. The case was tried to a judge. The trial court entered an order of condemnation.
2. *Centene Plaza Redevelopment Corporation v. Mint Properties*, Cause No. 06CC-002423 (Circuit Court of St. Louis County, 2006). I represented plaintiff Centene, and Jerry Carmody, 120 S. Central, Suite 1800, St. Louis, MO 63105 represented defendant property owners. This was a jurisdictional hearing in a condemnation action arising out of a Chapter 353 redevelopment project. The issues in the trial were whether the property in downtown Clayton was blighted pursuant to Chapter 353. The case was tried to a judge. I was lead trial counsel, handling the direct and cross-examination of most witnesses. The trial court entered an order of condemnation.
3. *LCRA v. Wimar*, Cause No. 042-08152 (Circuit Court of the City of St. Louis, 2006). I represented the Land Clearance for Redevelopment Authority and Jerry Carmody, 120 S. Central, Suite 1800, St. Louis, MO 63105 represented the property owner. This was a jurisdictional hearing in a condemnation action involving property on Laclede's Landing. The issue was whether the LCRA had acted in good faith in attempting to acquire the property for redevelopment purposes. I was sole trial counsel and handled all aspects of the trial. The case was tried to a judge. The case settled several months after evidence was concluded and post-trial briefing was completed.

I was lead trial counsel, handling voir dire, opening and closing, and examination of all but one witness. The property owner's demand was \$1.6 million. The jury awarded \$550,000.
