Travis Moorehead (Moorehead) appeals the trial court’s entry of judgment and sentence upon a jury’s verdict finding him guilty of robbery in the first degree.

AFFIRMED.

Division Three Holds: The trial court: (1) did not abuse its discretion in overruling Moorehead’s motion to strike a venireperson, because the venireperson’s responses during *voir dire* showed he could be fair and impartial; and (2) did not err in admitting identification evidence, because the identification procedure was not unduly suggestive, and Victim positively identified Moorehead from his recollection of first-hand observations.
