REVERSED AND REMANDED.

Division Four Holds: Based on the record on appeal, we find that the trial court's decision was arbitrary and unreasonable in all aspects, including the maintenance award, the child support award, the distribution of property, and the attorney's fees award. The award totals were without substantial evidence to support them and were so arbitrary and unreasonable that they indicated a lack of careful consideration.
