Minor J.L.T. appeals the judgment of the Juvenile Division of the Circuit Court of the City of St. Louis finding her guilty of Assault in the Second Degree, section 565.060.1(3), R.S.Mo. (Cum. Supp. 2007).

REVERSED AND J.L.T. DISCHARGED.

DIVISION FOUR HOLDS: The juvenile court plainly erred by finding J.L.T. guilty of an uncharged offense, section 565.060.1(3), that is not a lesser included offense of the charged offense, section 565.060.1(2), R.S.Mo. (Cum. Supp. 2007). Because this error violated her fundamental right to due process, J.L.T. suffered a manifest injustice. We reverse the juvenile court's judgment and order that J.L.T. be discharged.
