DIVISION ONE HOLDS: C.T. was discharged from St. Alexius prior to oral argument and the controversy is moot as a decision is no longer necessary and there is no effectual relief that can be granted. The case does not come within either of the two narrow exceptions to the mootness doctrine that would permit discretionary review by this Court.
