Arthur B. Robinson (Defendant) appeals from the judgment upon his conviction and sentence on one count of burglary in the first degree, in violation of Section 569.160, RSMo 2000.

REVERSED AND REMANDED.

Division One Holds: Because the trial court did not read mandatory instructions MAI-CR3d 300.06, 302.01, and 302.02 at the outset of trial, the jury did not receive sufficient guidance from the trial court and manifest injustice or a miscarriage of justice occurred. Failure to read the three preliminary instructions was accordingly plain error.
