Carol Ann Carlson appeals from the trial court’s Judgment entered upon a jury verdict in favor of Saint Louis University on a third-amended petition filed March 28, 2011, alleging personal injury to Carlson’s father, James Harris (Harris).¹

Division Four Holds: The trial court did not abuse its discretion in admitting Harris’s medical records because they were not hearsay, were relevant, and there was substantial evidence they were relied upon in Harris’s treatment.
