Edward Lawrence appeals from the denial of a motion he filed to set aside the judgment under Rule 29.12(b) for manifest injustice relating to alleged discovery violations at his 1984 trial.

DISMISSED

Division One holds:

Rule 29.12(b) does not provide an independent basis under which a person convicted of a crime can subsequently challenge his conviction or sentence. Therefore, we must dismiss the appeal.
