Linda S. Borchardt (“Wife”) appeals the trial court’s judgment modifying the amount of maintenance she receives from her ex-husband Frederick M. Borchardt. On appeal, Wife contends that the trial court failed to make requested findings of fact, erred in modifying Wife’s maintenance award, and abused its discretion in failing to award Wife attorney’s fees.

AFFIRMED.

DIVISION THREE HOLDS: Because Wife failed to preserve her allegation of error alleging that the trial court neglected to issue properly requested findings fact, and has failed to prove an abuse of discretion by the trial court in modifying her maintenance award and denying her attorney’s fees, we affirm.
