Glenn Joseph (Movant) appeals from the motion court’s judgment denying his Missouri Rule of Criminal Procedure 29.15¹ motion for post-conviction relief after an evidentiary hearing.

AFFIRMED.

Division Two Holds: The trial court did not clearly err in denying Movant’s 29.15 motion, because Movant failed to show either that trial counsel’s advice regarding whether to accept the State’s plea offer was deficient or that there was a reasonable probability he would have accepted the plea offer but for the alleged ineffective assistance of counsel.
