Joshua Hackman filed a Rule 24.035 motion for post-conviction relief alleging that his trial counsel was ineffective for failing to advise him prior to his plea that if his probation was revoked he may not receive credit towards his sentence for the time he spent on probation.

AFFIRMED.

DIVISION THREE HOLDS: Section 559.100.2 does not definitely, immediately, or automatically follow the entry of a guilty plea, and it is therefore a collateral consequence of a guilty plea about which plea counsel need not have advised Hackman.
