Daniel Nelson (Husband) appeals the judgment of the trial court dissolving his marriage to Angela M. Nelson (Wife). Husband argues that the judgment is against the weight of the evidence in its award of sole legal custody of the minor children to Wife, in the amount of visitation awarded as joint physical custody, in the division of property, and in the award of attorney’s fees to Wife.

AFFIRMED IN PART; REVERSED AND REMANDED IN PART.

Division Four Holds: The trial court’s findings are supported by substantial evidence and are not against the weight of the evidence. The trial court did not abuse its discretion in awarding sole legal custody of the children to Wife, in awarding attorney’s fees to Wife, or in valuing and distributing the marital property. We affirm the judgment of the trial court in all of these respects. However, the trial court failed to assign a physical custody schedule for the children for some events as required by Section 452.310.8(1). Thus, we reverse this portion of the judgment and remand to the trial court for the limited purpose of supplementing the children’s parenting plans to include all enumerated events in Section 452.310.8(1), and any such others as the trial court in its discretion determines are in the best interests of the children.
