George Aldridge (Aldridge) appeals *pro se* the trial court's judgment dismissing his petition for failure to state a claim against two corrections officers, Charla Francis and Jason Crawford (Officers).

AFFIRMED.

Division One Holds: Other than conclusory allegations, Aldridge pled no facts to sustain a claim that he had a right of property or right to immediate possession of the property listed in his petition. Therefore, Aldridge has not stated a claim on which relief may be granted under a theory of tortious conversion and the trial court did not err in granting the Officers' motion to dismiss for failure to state a claim.
