Linda Parrott (Relator) filed two Petitions for Writ of Prohibition with this Court seeking to prohibit the enforcement of Circuit Judge Sandra Martinez’s (Respondent) Orders of November 13, 2015, and December 4, 2015, in the actions State v. Linda Parrott, Circuit Court of St. Francois County, Missouri, Cause Nos. 10SF-CR01409-01 and 10SF-CR-02189-01, wherein Respondent found Relator in violation of and revoked her probation. Relator also seeks an order directing Respondent to enter an order discharging Relator from probation.

**PRELIMINARY ORDERS IN PROHIBITION MADE PERMANENT. REMANDED WITH INSTRUCTIONS.**

Writ Division Four Holds: Relator was entitled to earned compliance credits under Section 217.703,<sup>1</sup> therefore Relator’s probation period ended on January 9, 2015. Because Respondent failed to conduct a revocation hearing or to make a reasonable effort to conduct said hearing prior to the expiration of Relator’s probationary period as required by Section 559.036, Respondent lacked jurisdiction to enter the November and December 2015 orders. The preliminary orders in prohibition previously issued in this case are made permanent.
