OPINION SUMMARY

John Doe ("Appellant") appeals from a judgment of the Circuit Court of St. Louis County granting summary judgment, on all of Appellant's claims, in favor of Gene Overall, former Sheriff of St. Louis County; Jerry Lee, St. Louis County Chief of Police; and James Keathley, Superintendent of the Missouri Highway Patrol (Collectively "Respondents"). The main issue on appeal is whether Appellant must continue to register in Missouri even though the triggering offense was committed in Iowa before the effective date of Megan's Law.

AFFIRMED.

DIVISION FIVE HOLDS: The Appellant has an independent obligation to register in Missouri under SORNA, and this obligation includes current registration requirements under Megan's Law.
