OPINION SUMMARY

John Doe ("Appellant") appeals from a judgment of the Circuit Court of St. Louis County granting summary judgment, on all of Appellant's claims, in favor of Gene Overall, former Sheriff of St. Louis County; Jerry Lee, St. Louis County Chief of Police; and James Keathley, Superintendent of the Missouri Highway Patrol (Collectively "Respondents"). The main issue on appeal is whether SORA can be applied to require Appellant to continue with his registration requirements even though the triggering offense was committed in Iowa before the effective date of SORA.

DISMISSED.

DIVISION FIVE HOLDS: The appeal is moot because this court will not be able to grant Appellant any effectual relief in that, regardless of this court's decision, Appellant will be required to register in Missouri under SORA as mandated by SORNA and 28 C.F.R. Section 72.3.
