**OPINION SUMMARY**

Naomi Hoer (hereinafter, "Hoer") filed two motions seeking to hold Robert E. Small (hereinafter, "Small") and D.M.C. Family Partnership, L.P. in contempt for violating a charging order and seeking to have a receiver appointed. The trial court denied Hoer's motions, entering judgment in favor of Small.

REVERSED AND REMANDED.

Division Two Holds: The record on appeal is incomplete due to the trial court's failure to rule on the admissibility of evidence thereby precluding appellate review.
