Robert F. Wheeler (“Wheeler”) appeals the judgment of the trial court entering orders of protection in favor of Jennifer R. MacFarlane (“MacFarlane”) pursuant to the Adult Abuse Act and in favor of Jennifer R. MacFarlane on behalf of her daughters, K.L.H. and A.M. pursuant to the Child Protection Orders Act. Wheeler argues none of the orders were supported by sufficient evidence.

DISMISSED.

NORTHERN DIVISION HOLDS: The orders of protection at issue in the present appeal expired, and therefore the issues before us are moot. We decline to exercise our discretion to review the issues because they do not fall within either exception to the mootness doctrine.
