Richard Roche (Husband) appeals from the trial court’s Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage (Judgment) dissolving his marriage with Donna Roche (Wife), dividing the marital and non-marital property, awarding Wife maintenance, and awarding Wife attorney fees.

**AFFIRM IN PART. REVERSE AND REMAND IN PART.**

Division One Holds: The trial court did not err in awarding the marital home to Wife or in exercising jurisdiction over Husband’s trust. Further, the trial court did not abuse its discretion in awarding Wife maintenance. The trial court did err in failing to include a legal description of the parties’ marital residence in its Judgment. We therefore reverse the Judgment with respect to the omission and remand the cause to the trial court with directions to enter an amended judgment that contains the legal description of the Residence. We affirm the remainder of the Judgment.
