The Director of Revenue, State of Missouri (“DOR”) appeals the judgment of the trial court ordering Edward Joseph Renner, Jr.’s (“Renner”) commercial driver’s license reinstated. The DOR argues the court erroneously set aside the disqualification of Renner’s commercial driver’s license (“CDL”) because such disqualification was proper under the relevant statutory provisions.

REVERSED AND REMANDED.

DIVISION THREE HOLDS: The trial court erred in setting aside the disqualification of Renner’s commercial driver’s license because he was convicted of driving a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol and thus, subject to disqualification.
