OPINION SUMMARY

Carolynne Kieffer (Plaintiff) appeals from the judgment of the Circuit Court of the City of St. Louis in favor of Jennifer Icaza, Ramiro Icaza and, Dianne Icaza (Defendants). Plaintiff claims that the trial court erred in: (1) denying her motion for jury trial, and (2) entering its May 29, 2008 judgment more than 30 days after the case was taken under submission which rendered the judgment void.

REMANDED

Division Two Holds: The trial court erred in entering its May 29, 2008 judgment more than thirty days after it took the case under submission and without the consent of the parties in violation of Section 517.111.2, and therefore the judgment is void.
