OPINION SUMMARY

Tracy Dennis appeals the judgment entered upon a jury verdict convicting him of two counts of misdemeanor assault of a law enforcement officer. Dennis argues the trial court erred in granting the State's motion in limine and excluding evidence of cameras in the police station.

AFFIRMED.

Division Three holds: The trial court did not abuse its discretion in determining that the evidence of the presence of cameras was inadmissible.
