In this action to save the San Luis Apartment Building from demolition, the Friends of the San Luis, Inc., appeals the circuit court’s judgment dismissing its petition for lack of standing.

APPEAL DISMISSED; CAUSE REMANDED WITH INSTRUCTIONS

DIVISION THREE HOLDS: Because the building was demolished shortly after the circuit court’s judgment, we find that the case is moot. We also conclude that the case does not fall within any exception to the mootness doctrine.
