Casey Hollins (“Defendant”) appeals from the trial court’s judgment and sentence after a jury found him guilty of the Class B felony assault in the first degree, armed criminal action, and unlawful use of a weapon.

AFFIRM IN PART; REMAND IN PART

Division One Holds: The written judgment does not accurately reflect the indictment or the oral judgment and sentencing. Therefore, we remand to the trial court with directions to correct the clerical error on the written judgment, changing it to reflect the Class B felony of assault in the first degree.
