Taylor Poole (Claimant) appeals from the November 23, 2009 decision of the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission (Commission), affirming and adopting the awards of the Administrative Law Judge.

AFFIRMED IN PART and REVERSED and REMANDED IN PART.

Division Three Holds: The Commission’s decision with regard to Claimant’s disability determinations, denial of past medical expenses and interest, and denial of conditional survivor benefits is not against the overwhelming weight of the evidence and is supported by substantial evidence. The Commission’s decision denying future medical expenses is not supported by substantial evidence.
