Louie S. Andrews appeals the judgment of the Circuit Court of St. Louis County, the Honorable Dale W. Hood, presiding. Andrews appeals the court's award of attorney's and legal fees to his ex-wife, Amy Andrews, n/k/a Amy Coleman (Coleman). Andrews claims the trial court erred in granting Coleman's attorney's and legal fees because she was capable of paying the fees herself and because it was Coleman, not Andrews, who unnecessarily prolonged the litigation.

AFFIRMED.

DIVISION ONE HOLDS: The Circuit Court properly considered all the statutory factors regarding an award of attorney's and legal fees. Based on the record as a whole, the court's order was within the limits of judicial discretion.
