Quintin Gray (Appellant) appeals from the trial court’s judgment and sentence entered upon a jury verdict convicting him of second-degree murder and abuse of a child (causing death).

On appeal, Appellant argues the trial court erred in excluding the admission of a 911 tape and a reenactment video on the basis of hearsay; in admitting evidence of prior misconduct by Appellant against the victim and expert testimony that the victim’s injuries were consistent with abusive behavior; in limiting the opinion testimony of Appellant’s expert due to the expert’s reliance on Appellant’s hearsay statements; and in entering judgment and sentence against Appellant for conventional second-degree murder and abuse of child (causing death) in violation of his rights against double jeopardy.

AFFIRMED.

Division Three Holds: The trial court did not abuse its discretion in the admission and exclusion of evidence at trial, nor did the trial court err in entering judgment and sentence against Appellant for both conventional second-degree murder and abuse of a child (causing death).
