Phillip Schneider (Schneider) appeals from the judgment of the Circuit Court of St. Charles County upholding the Director of Revenue's suspension of Schneider's driving privileges. Schneider contends that the trial court erred in admitting the results of his breath alcohol test because the test failed to comply with Mo. Rev. Stat. §§ 577.020-577.041 (Cum. Supp. 2006).

AFFIRMED

Division Five Holds: We find no basis to conclude Schneider's breath alcohol test failed to comply with Sections 577.020.-577.041, such that the trial court erred in admitting the results of the test.
