Willie Cooper (Cooper) appeals from the motion court's judgment denying his Rule 24.035 motion for post-conviction relief on the merits, without an evidentiary hearing, after he pleaded guilty to stealing over \$500.

DISMISSED.

Division Four Holds: Cooper voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waived his right to file a petition for post-conviction relief as part of his plea agreement, thus we dismiss Cooper's appeal with directions to the motion court to vacate its judgment and dismiss Cooper's amended post-conviction motion.
