Dominic Mosby appeals the judgment of the Circuit Court of the City of St. Louis. The Circuit Court entered judgment against Mosby convicting him of second-degree burglary.

AFFIRMED.

DIVISION ONE HOLDS: The Circuit Court, the Honorable Bryan L. Hettenbach presiding, did not err in entering judgment against Dominic Mosby convicting him of second-degree burglary. The State adduced sufficient evidence for a jury to find beyond a reasonable doubt that Mosby knowingly unlawfully entered a business office owned by Scott Miller between 16 and 18 May 2009 for the purpose of stealing. Therefore, we affirm that decision.
