Marian Adele Ware (Mother) appeals from the judgment of the Circuit Court of St. Charles County denying her motion to set aside and vacate judgments entered in 2002 and 2005 modifying the child support provisions of a Texas court's 1994 Decree of Divorce (Texas Judgment). Mother claims the trial court lacked subject matter jurisdiction under the Uniform Interstate Family Support Act (UIFSA) to modify the Texas Judgment.

AFFIRMED

Division Five Holds: The trial court did not err in denying Mother's motion to set aside and vacate the 2002 and 2005 judgments because the trial court had subject matter jurisdiction over the parties' dispute and Mother's unpreserved claims were waived.
