T.E. (Father) appeals from the circuit court's entry of a permanency plan pursuant to Section 210.720 RSMo 2006 denying Father's request for custody of Child.

Respondent Juvenile Officer filed a Motion to Dismiss Father's appeal contending that Father is appealing from an order that is not a final judgment and Father has no statutory right to appeal.

DISMISSED.

Division Three Holds: The circuit court's Order and Judgment on Permanency Hearing pursuant to Section 210.720 is not an appealable judgment. Respondent Juvenile Officer's Motion to Dismiss is granted.
