C.B. sought renewal of a previously granted full order of protection against her former boyfriend, J.B. Following a hearing, the trial court entered judgment, ordering renewal of the full order of protection for another year. On appeal, J.B. argues the trial court erred because the judgment was not supported by substantial evidence and the trial court erroneously applied the law.

AFFIRMED.

Division One Holds: The trial court did not err in ordering renewal of the full order of protection. Substantial evidence was adduced that allowing the original full order of protection to expire would place C.B. in an immediate and present danger of abuse. Moreover, the trial court properly applied the facts and circumstances of the case to this Court's well-established standard for the renewal of full orders of protection.
