Robert Jamison appeals his conviction of two counts of first-degree robbery, one count of first-degree attempted robbery, and three counts of armed criminal action. Jamison claims the trial court erred in denying his motion to dismiss for violations of the Interstate Agreement on Detainers, in denying his motion to strike a prospective juror for cause, and allowing a witness to testify regarding past victimization.

AFFIRMED.
