Eileen Davis Young (Claimant) appeals the decision of the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission denying her unemployment benefits based upon its finding that Washington University School of Medicine (Employer) terminated Claimant for misconduct connected with her work.

Division Four Holds: The Commission's conclusion that Claimant was discharged for misconduct connected with her work was not supported by competent and substantial evidence.
