Terrese Greene (Plaintiff) appeals the trial court's grant of summary judgment to Janet Schneider, Terri Coates, and Joseph Conley (collectively, "Defendants") on Plaintiff's claim of negligence and/or civil conspiracy. Plaintiff contends that the trial court erred in finding that Plaintiff's claim of civil conspiracy fails as a matter of law and that the doctrines of official immunity and public duty shield Defendants from liability.

AFFIRMED.

Division Four Holds: The trial court did not err in granting summary judgment for Defendants. Plaintiff's claim of civil conspiracy fails as a matter of law because a violation of Section 537.360 cannot serve as the wrongful act underlying a civil conspiracy claim.
