The wife, Rebecca Passanante, appeals the judgment entered by the Circuit Court of Warren County in favor of the husband, Paul Passanante, terminating the wife’s maintenance award and denying her request for attorney’s fees.

**REVERSED IN PART AND AFFIRMED IN PART**

**DIVISION TWO HOLDS:** Because no substantial evidence supports the trial court’s judgment that the husband established a continuing change in circumstances through the reduction of his income, we reverse the termination of maintenance. Because the wife failed to deposit with this Court all exhibits necessary for the determination of the issue of attorney’s fees, we affirm the portion of the judgment denying her an award of attorney’s fees.
