Leroy Brewer (“Brewer”) appeals from the trial court’s judgment convicting Brewer of failure to abate a nuisance under City of Perryville (“City”) Ordinance. The trial court found that Brewer kept an inoperable mobile home on his property and failed to remedy the condition after receiving notice that such violated City ordinance. On appeal, Brewer alleges multiple errors.

DISMISSED

Division Four holds: Brewer’s brief substantially fails to comply with the briefing requirements of Mo. R. Civ. P. 84.04 (2011) such that Brewer has preserved nothing for appellate review. Accordingly, we dismiss Brewer’s appeal.
