Appellant Deutsche Bank National Trust Company (“Bank”) appeals the circuit court’s denial of its motion to set aside a default judgment arising from a quiet title suit brought by Respondents Ramaiah and Sreedevi Maddipati (“the Maddipatis”).

AFFIRMED.

DIVISION TWO HOLDS: The circuit court did not err denying the motion to set aside default judgment because Bank failed to demonstrate good cause as to why it failed to answer the Maddipati’s petition to quiet title. Additionally, Bank failed to demonstrate the applicability of the plain error rule to the appeal.
