

## OPINION SUMMARY

Husband appeals and Wife cross-appeals from the dissolution judgment of the trial court awarding her child support and maintenance. Husband argues the trial court erred in its calculations for the child support award, the maintenance award, and the distribution of marital assets. On cross-appeal, Wife argues the trial court erred in its award of \$350,000 from Husband's retirement accounts because the judgment failed to specify from which retirement account(s) Wife would receive her award.

AFFIRMED IN PART, REVERSED IN PART, AND REMANDED.

Division Three holds: The trial court erred in failing to specify from which retirement accounts Wife would be entitled to her award and whether she would be entitled to appreciation. On remand, the trial court should decide how much Wife will receive from each of Husband's three retirement accounts, whether Wife is entitled to appreciation on those accounts, and any other clarification required so that Wife may prepare a Qualified Domestic Relations Order.
