Wife appeals from a decree of dissolution of marriage. On appeal, she challenges the trial court's award of non-modifiable monthly maintenance limited to a period of thirty-six months.

REVERSED IN PART; MODIFIED IN PART; AFFIRMED AS MODIFIED.

Division Two holds:

There was no substantial evidence that wife's financial condition was subject to an impending change that would cause wife to become self-sufficient thirty-six months after the decree was entered.
