In this consolidated appeal, Thurston Byers (“Claimant”) appeals from the orders of the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission (“Commission”) affirming the Missouri Division of Employment Security’s (“Division”) appeals tribunal’s decisions that Claimant (1) failed to timely appeal a deputy’s determination of disqualification, which became final, and (2) he was therefore overpaid unemployment compensation benefits during a period of disqualification.

AFFIRMED.
