Lorie Plengemeier (Appellant) appeals from the trial court’s judgment dismissing her petition alleging claims of gender discrimination in her employment under the Missouri Human Rights Act (MHRA) against Thermadyne Industries, Inc. and Joseph F. Mueller (Respondents) as time-barred by the statute of limitations.

REVERSED and REMANDED.

Division One Holds: The trial court erred in dismissing Appellant’s claim of gender discrimination by Respondents under the MHRA as barred by the statute of limitations because it was timely filed under the continuing violations doctrine.
