Richard Barnes ("Father") appeals from the trial court's judgment modifying a prior dissolution judgment and child custody decree.

AFFIRMED.

Division One Holds: The trial court did not err in denying Father's Motion to Dismiss Mother's Motion to Modify the prior Child Custody Decree, because Missouri's relocation statute, Section 452.377, was inapplicable under these facts. This was a child custody modification case, pursuant to Section 452.410. As such, finding no error in the trial court's modification, this Court affirms the trial court's modification of the prior Child Custody Decree, pursuant to Section 452.410.
