Gjergji Kotini (Kotini) appeals from the trial court’s judgment entered in favor of Century Surety Company (Century) in Kotini’s equitable garnishment action against Century. Kotini seeks to satisfy a judgment he obtained against Century’s insured, Dante’s LLC and Anthony Williams.

AFFIRMED.

Division Two Holds: The trial court did not err in entering judgment in favor of Century because the insurance policy’s assault and battery provision excluding coverage for bodily injury is not vague and ambiguous and the court properly found Kotini’s injuries fell within said exclusion.
