John J. Smith (“Appellant”) appeals from the judgment dismissing with prejudice his petition for declaratory judgment, in which he sought to have the 2007 judgment dissolving his marriage to Lora J. Smith (“Respondent”) declared void. Respondent has filed a motion to dismiss the appeal, arguing that Appellant has failed to comply with Rule 84.04 and Rule 81.12.

DISMISSED.

Division Two holds: Appellant’s brief does not comply with Rule 84.04, and the record is incomplete under Rule 81.12. Therefore, Respondent’s motion to dismiss is granted.
